POSITION DESCRIPTION

Assistant Teachers work in the classroom from 9:00am-2:00pm and transition to Aftercare support from 2:00-5:30pm. A minimum of 3-6 Early Childhood Education (ECE) units are preferred and a willingness to work toward 6 ECE units during employment is a requirement. The ideal candidate has experience working with preschool-aged children in a diverse and inclusive environment.
